About the survey

The aim of the European Social Fund (ESF) survey is to find out how participation in ESF-funded activities or the provision of support has influenced a person's situation in the labour market. The results of the survey are used to draw conclusions on the effectiveness of ESF activities.

Feedback is collected with a sample survey among persons who have participated in activities under ESF measures. The sample includes persons who have participated in one or more ESF-funded activities.

As a rule, respondents are sent a separate questionnaire with three questions concerning each specific activity or support.
